Daily Maths Tasks

- Every day, please ensure your child accesses [DoodleMaths](#). We check this throughout the week to monitor how individuals are progressing and to set specific 'added extra' tasks for pupils to complete. Please ensure your child also logs in to [Times Table Rockstars](#) and [Numbots](#) to practise their fluency facts. Your child can access all of these programmes with their school logins.
- Moving forwards we are advising you to use the following website to work on daily maths video lessons. The materials on this website contain videos, quizzes and worksheets. The site has been backed by the government and has been created to support families with home learning during the coronavirus lockdown.

Daily English Tasks

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

- Every day, please ensure that your child accesses Spelling Shed.
- Complete the grammar activity sheets – see the 'Extras' tab under the Year 1 tab.

Reading

Every day spend 30 minutes reading. Make a note of any vocabulary you are unsure of and find out what the words mean.

Every Monday read through the Poem of the Week (this can be found on the school's Twitter page – link is [here](#)). Create a 5Ps poster with the headings, Likes/Dislikes, Patterns and Connections, Puzzles and Possibilities, Predictions and Picture and record your responses to the poem. Once you have read it through and recorded your responses, discuss your ideas with someone else in your family.

Choose [Extract 1](#) or [Extract 2](#) and read it aloud daily until you can read it effortlessly and fluently like your teacher. Perform it to someone on Friday or record yourself and ask an adult to email it to someone at school who you would like to share it with.

Complete the '[Velociraptors](#)' comprehension.

Phonics

Complete a [phonics](#) session daily. If you have not yet completed phonics work at home, start with lesson 1. Otherwise, continue from the last sound you learnt.

Writing Choose one of the following:

- Complete the 5 lessons on writing a character description (unit 8) on [Oak Academy](#)
- Complete a [Talk for Writing Home School unit](#) and complete it by the end of the week.

Tuesday	Geography – Learn about the continents and either create a continents fact book or label the continents of the world (both can be accessed via the Year 1 tab of the website)

Thursday	DT – Begin the plastic challenge on the STEM website (look at the activity sheets p.1-6 and then p.9 identifying plastics)	
Friday	Computing – Sign up to barefoot computing and learn about algorithms . Have a go at creating your own algorithm!
