Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach the end of term, we would like to let you know about our plans to mark the end of Year 6's time at The Ridge. Even though we will not be able to host many of our traditional end of Year 6 activities, we hope that we will be able to make the children's last few weeks special.

Planned Activities for the Children Currently in School

Sports Day - Wednesday 8th July (15th July reserve)

The children will be taking part in a range of carousel activities (including discus, shotput and the egg and spoon race) as well as some flat races. The children will need to wear their PE kit on this day and please can you make sure that the children have a sun hat and a water bottle with them and that they put on sun cream before school. (Please note that this will be just for the children - we are unable to invite parents to Sports Day on this occasion)

Fish and Chips afternoon - Friday 10th July

We are going to host our traditional fish and chips treat afternoon for the children (more details will follow). We will also play some socially distanced games during the afternoon. We will be in touch to ask for children's choices, the cost will be covered by a kind donation from RFA.

Shirt Signing - Thursday 16th July

If the children would like to, they can bring in a school shirt to be signed on this day. We will lay these out on tables so that children are able to sign each other's shirts. Please can we ask that the children bring and use their own pen.
