## Daily Maths Tasks

- Every day, please ensure your child accesses [DoodleMaths](#). We check this throughout the week to monitor how individuals are progressing and to set specific 'added extra' tasks for pupils to complete. Please ensure your child also logs in [Times Table Rockstars](#) and [Numbots](#) to practise their fluency facts. Your child can access all of these programmes with their school logins.
- Moving forwards we are advising you to use the following website to work on daily maths video lessons. The materials on this website contain videos, quizzes and worksheets. The site has been backed by the government and has been created to support families with home learning during the coronavirus lockdown.

## Daily English Tasks

### Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

- Every day, please ensure that your child accesses Spelling Shed.
- Complete the grammar activity sheets – see the 'Extras' tab under the Year 1 tab.

### Reading

Every day spend 30 minutes reading. Make a note of any vocabulary you are unsure of and find out what the words mean.

Every Monday read through the Poem of the Week (this can be found on the school's Twitter page – link is [here](#)). Create a 5Ps poster with the headings, Likes/Dislikes, Patterns and Connections, Puzzles and Possibilities, Predictions and Picture and record your responses to the poem. Once you have read it through and recorded your responses, discuss your ideas with someone else in your family.

Choose [Extract 1](#) or [Extract 2](#) and read it aloud daily until you can read it effortlessly and fluently like your teacher. Perform it to someone on Friday or record yourself and ask an adult to email it to someone at school who you would like to share it with.

Complete the ['Habitats'](#) comprehension.

### Phonics

- Complete a [phonics](#) session daily. If you have not yet completed phonics work at home, start with lesson 1. Otherwise, continue from the last sound you learnt.

### Writing

- Complete a [Talk for Writing Home School unit](#). This will take you this week and next week.

## Daily Curriculum Task

Monday	Science – Watch the video <a href="#">what are fish?</a> Learn about fish, our final animal group. Following this, have a go at the Twinkl worksheets under the Year 1 tab to show what you have learnt over the last few weeks.
Tuesday	DT – Go from p.29 of the <a href="#">activity sheets</a> and then use p.33 and 34 to design your own product!
Wednesday	History – Watch the <a href="#">video</a> about Florence Nightingale's life and read the PowerPoint (under Year 1 tab on website). Complete the worksheet (under Year 1 tab) explaining how she changed the way people nursed.
Thursday	Geography – Learn about <a href="#">Nigeria</a> and then have a look at the rainforest PowerPoint (under Year 1 tab). Complete animal fact file worksheet (under Year 1 tab)
