Daily Maths Tasks

- Every day, please ensure your child accesses [DoodleMaths](#). - Read the extract of [You Can't Call an Elephant in an Emergency](#) with an adult, as some words might be a bit tricky. What other animals couldn't you call in an emergency and why not? You could then act out part of the story as a new character. You might need to set up a username and password to access it.

Daily Curriculum Task – People Who Help Us		Physical Activity
Monday	Science –Investigating Materials – glass, wood, plastic, metal, fabric - go on a hunt around your home. What can you find made by each material?	Daily PE with Joe Wicks GoNoodle Cosmic Kids Yoga
Tuesday	In the story above, the elephant takes the place of a fire fighter, draw and label people who help us.	
Wednesday	Paint a picture of someone who helps you, it could be a family member or someone like a police officer.	
Thursday	Listen to the story of Peace at Last – Talk about why sleep is important. You could draw your bedtime routine. For example brush your teeth, get into bed.	
Friday	Invent and make a machine – what job will your machine have? You could use boxes or lego to make a model of it.
