Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you and your family are all keeping well.

We are continuing to make our plans for all the children to return safely to school in September. We are really looking forward to welcoming everyone back and being together as a school community once again, after the changes to our way of life that we have all seen over the past few months. As you can imagine, the logistics of a safe return are proving challenging as we try to work through how our day will be structured: we are basing our plans on the procedures, which have worked well for our small bubbles of children but looking at the best way to scale them up.

Parents and carers of children in Reception will be contacted separately and given information of their induction programme and full time start date. Separate information will also go out to Kindergarten parents and carers. On Friday 4th September, we will be asking all children to bring a packed lunch. We will be offering a catering service from Monday 7th September, although initially this will consist of grab bags only.
